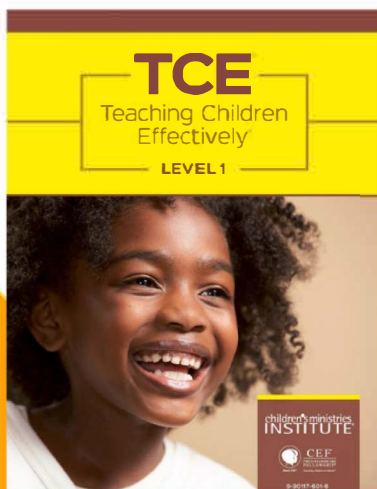
Are you looking for some **classroom management** techniques?

Emphasis is placed on organizing and conducting enjoyable classroom activities that enrich children spiritually.

In addition to regular coursework, three practicum sessions conducted during the course provide each student with evaluated experience in applying the theory and thought. Students are also required to participate in teaching five children's classes within six months of completing the course to receive a certificate. All course instructors specialize in children's ministry and are credentialed by *Child Evangelism Fellowship®*.

- At least 15 years of age
- Willing to participate in all class activities, including practicum sessions.
